Program Note:

*Rubha Hunish* (pronounced “rue’ah hoon’ish”) is a location on the tip of the Isle of Skye in Scotland. This music is inspired by the Gaelic folk music native to the region. The first half of the piece is a stylized strathspey, which attempts to capture both a sense of lyricism and the snappy rhythms associated with the dance; the second half is a jig. *Rubha Hunish* was commissioned by Lisa Bost, and is dedicated to John White and Anne Martin.
