I have lived in Charlottesville, my wife grew up there, and our family has visited many times. This tragedy shook us to the core. For some reason, Oscar Peterson's great Civil Rights Era anthem, "Hymn to Freedom," repeatedly played in my mind as I read about the events of the weekend and saw photos. This piano solo is a kind of fantasy based on Peterson's music, and is a tribute to those who stand up to hatred and fearmongering.
