These short meditations are based on Gregorian chants associated with the four sundays in Advent. Each piece begins with a free, unmetered rendition of the chant, followed by a musical elaboration that uses the chant as a starting point. They are each roughly two minutes in duration, and were composed between 2013-2015.

## I. Ad te levavi To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul. O my God, in you I trust; do not let me be put to shame; do not let my enemies exult over me. Do not let those who wait for you be put to shame; let them be ashamed who are wantonly treacherous. (Psalm 25: 1-3, NRSV) II. Ex Sion species decoris [Hear this, all you peoples; give ear, all inhabitants of the world,] both low and high, rich and poor together. My mouth shall speak wisdom; the meditation of my heart shall be understanding. (Psalm 49: 2-3, NRSV) III. Qui sedes, Domine Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, you who lead Joseph like a flock! You who are enthroned upon the cherubim, shine forth before Ephraim and Benjamin and Manasseh. Stir up your might, and come to save us! (Psalm 80: 1-3, NRSV) IV. Rorate Caeli Shower, O heavens, from above, and let the skies rain down righteousness; let the earth open, that salvation may spring up, and let it cause righteousness to sprout up also; I the Lord have created it. (Isaiah 45:8, NRSV)
